'Sound Walk, Talk'

Escoitar.org is a sound art collective made up of anthropologists, ethno-musicologists, musicians, artists and web designers. For the last years they have been doing research about sound/place connections as well as their cultural and aesthetic meanings.

Escoitar are in Estonia to produce a sound-walk for the KUMU Gateways exhibition. They are working with "noTours", a locative system designed by them, based on open source code (Android) using GPS and digital compass technology. This system displays audios and interviews creating geo-located stories focusing on the cultural meanings of sound. Throughout this week, they have been carrying out technical and conceptual sound workshops at KUMU.
